Where Can I Be An Intern?

Partners In Education is working with area businesses and organizations to find placements for Woodward & Scott students that **fit your individual interests**. We will place you in an internship that is accessible by bus so that you can get to your internship quickly and safely.

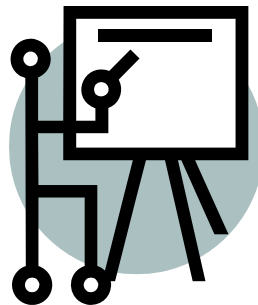
What Do I Need to Do?

First, you need to complete an Intern application form and submit it to Mr. Thayer or your school counselor.

Students who qualify to participate, based upon credits earned, attendance and academic record, will be interviewed. Twenty-five applicants will be chosen for the program.

What Happens When I'm Accepted?

You will be enrolled in the Internship program and you will participate in a 7th period class. You will begin your internship assignment as soon as the coordinator finds the appropriate job site and the teacher determines that you are ready for placement.

How Does It Work?

The course requires you to attend a 7th period class until you begin interning. Your internship assignment will require six hours of participation each week with the opportunity for early release from class.

The Odyssey internship coordinator will require you to turn in regular attendance verification and a few papers or projects through the year. However, your biggest responsibility will be getting to your internship site and doing the best you can.

Students enrolled in the program use **TARTA free of charge** to get to and from the internship assignment, or you can drive.

The Partners In Education Odyssey coordinator (and your teacher) will be available to you to **help you be successful** in your internship.
